### IMPORTANT

Each declaration of membership must be completed by (or at the direction of) the party member concerned and then signed by the member. **Particulars to be completed are to be written by hand at the same time the form is signed.** Each declaration of membership is to be made on a separate sheet of paper.

The Electoral Commissioner may, in order to verify the requirements for registration of a party, request a person who signs a declaration of membership to confirm that the person is a member of the party and that the person completed and signed the form.

Under the provisions of *Parliamentary Electorates and Elections Act 1912* and the *Local Government Act 1993* this declaration is available for public inspection.
